Event Assistant Leather Lane Conservation Group
Based at location
Leather Lane, nr Great Missenden - http://leatherlane.org/ (Poor access – steep & uneven)
Purpose of the role
Assist with guiding visitors on Bat Walks.
Type of work in which you will be involved
Looking after small groups of visitors on Leather Lane – watching out for (infrequent) traffic, answering questions regarding the bats
Skills required:
Interest in Bats, although other volunteers can provide all the information required.
Suitable for Under 18s
No – due to road safety issues.
Times/days we would like you to be available
Walks take place at weekends, starting half an hour before sunset, and last 1.5-2 hours.
Benefits to volunteer & possible training opportunities
Opportunity to learn about bats and wildlife. Meet and engage with local people attending the walks. Develop experience of hosting wildlife walks. Possibility of developing deeper knowledge of bat ecology.
