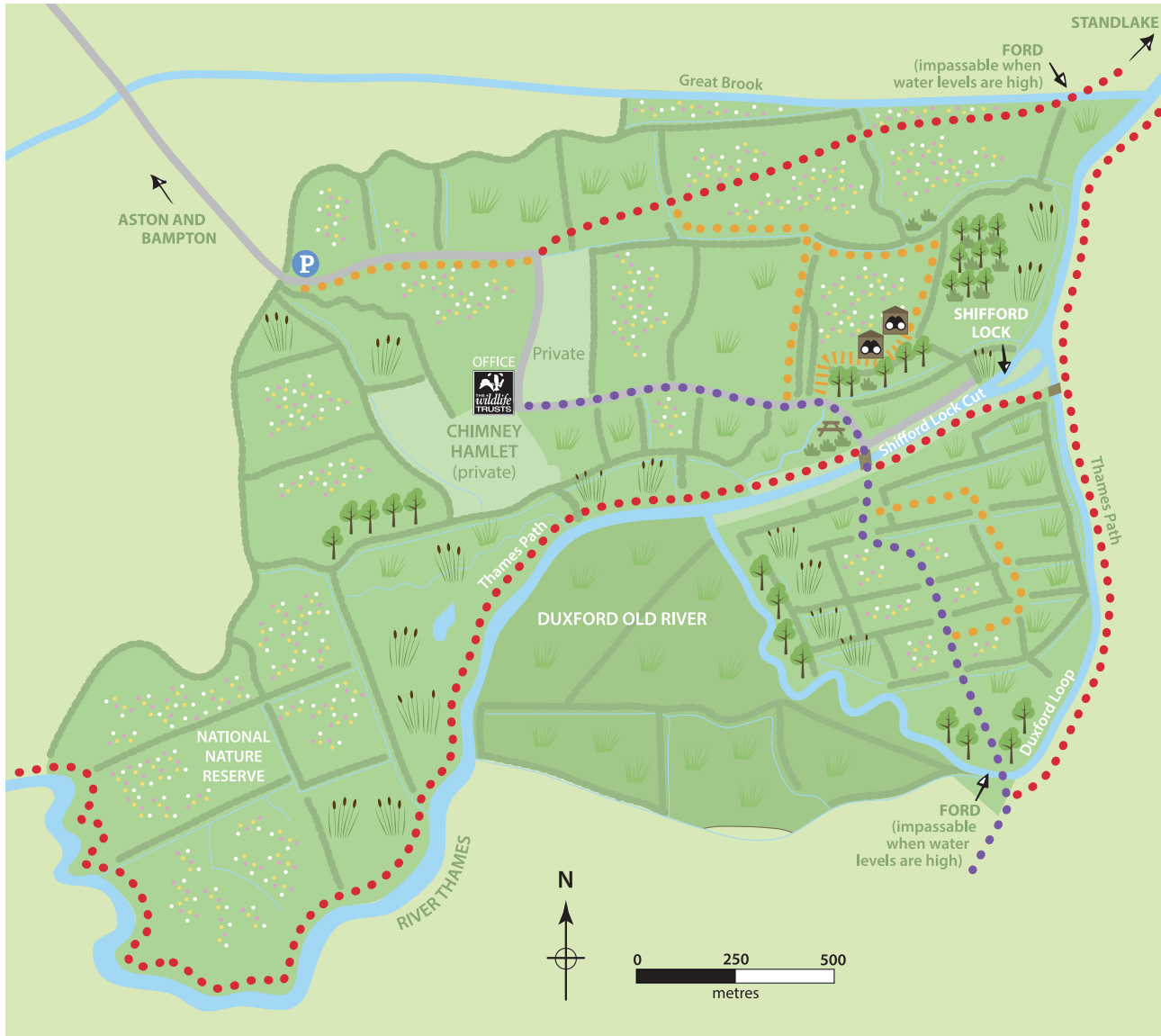


# Welcome to Chimney Meadows

Chimney Meadows is one of the Berks Bucks and Oxon Wildlife Trust's biggest nature reserves. This ancient landscape is home to nationally-important wildflower meadows and provides a vital refuge for wading birds and wildfowl.
