<b>Based at location</b>
Various BBOWT nature reserves in Oxfordshire.
<b>Purpose of the role</b>
The Midweek Team carries out a wide variety of practical tasks to maintain and enhance BBOWT's many nature reserves in Oxfordshire.
<b>Type of work you will be involved in</b>
Work includes Fencing, coppicing, late-summer meadow cutting, raking, path clearance and access work, scrub clearance and more.
<b>Experience &amp;/or qualifications needed</b>
No experience is necessary as full training will be given for the task, we just need keen and happy people. Own transport preferable to get to the various sites, but limited spaces for lifts may be available. We are generally out whatever the weather, and there are no facilities on our reserves. A reasonable level of fitness is required.
<b>Times/days we would like you to be available</b>
Wednesdays.
<b>Benefits to volunteer &amp; possible training opportunities</b>
Working on a range of nature reserves helping to enhance our local wildlife, as part of a small, regular, committed group of people. Volunteers receive a full health & Safety briefing, and a brief history of the site, its wildlife interest and management, plus an explanation of the task for the day and why it is being carried out.
