Windsor Hill Volunteer Stock Watcher

<b>Purpose of the role:</b>
To help ensure the health and welfare of BBOWT's sheep as they graze this nature reserve.
<b>Type of work you will be involved in:</b>
You will help keep an eye on the Trust's flock of Hebridean sheep, visiting the site once a week to check that they are healthy and have water. You'll also need to check fences are in good repair. If there are any signs of poor condition, illness, or damage, you will report this to Land Management staff. These checks are in addition to those carried out by staff.
<b>Experience &amp;/or qualifications needed:</b>
No previous experience necessary as full training will be provided. You'll need to be comfortable around sheep, reliable and a good communicator. Please note that this is a remote site with uneven and sloped terrain.
