Chinnor Hill is a patchwork of flowery grassland, scrub, and woodland, with magnificent views over the Vale of Aylesbury. The work party maintains this SSI (Site of Special Scientific Interest) important chalk hillside reserve by clearing scrub and preserving the ancient footpaths.

There will be a wide range of tasks for you to choose from such as raking, pruning, scrub clearing, path clearance, chalk grassland maintenance, and access works.
