Leather Lane (SP895033), near Gt Missenden (access is steep, narrow and uneven)

Purpose of the role

Surveying and monitoring wildlife and plant life at Leather Lane to establish what plant life is present on the lane and surroundings, and gauge what use wildlife makes of the Lane

Type of work in which you will be involved

- Setting up monitoring equipment, looking at camera footage, writing up data, and conducting visual surveys.
- > Baseline/Audit of wildlife in Leather Lane.
- Monitoring activity and health of wildlife, to establish trends (during HS2 construction) so that LLCG can effectively direct its mitigation efforts.

- Ability to collect data and produce a report on the current state of the Lane (LLCG have some funding and equipment).
- Knowledge of plants or wildlife.
