Purpose of the role:
The Foxholes volunteer work party carries out a variety of practical tasks to maintain and enhance the Foxholes nature reserve.
Type of work you will be involved in:
Work includes: Maintaining and installing various site infrastructure such as horse barriers and fences, summer path cutting, other access work.
Experience &/or qualifications needed:
No experience necessary as full training will be given, we just need keen and happy people. Own transport needed to get to the site, car park is limited so car shares will be encouraged therefore living locally is a plus. We're generally out whatever the weather, and there are no facilities on the reserve.
Times/days we would like you to be available (flexibility is often possible):
Fridays, work parties are at least seasonal e.g. Winter, Spring, Summer, Autumn, with ad hoc work parties added where a task cannot be finished in one session. Dates are coordinated via the group leader.
Benefits to volunteer & possible training opportunities:
Full training for all tasks undertaken, and information provided about the site, its wildlife and the purpose of the task. You will be helping to maintain the nature reserve as part of a small, regular, committed group of people. Depending on regularity and availability there may be opportunities to attend first aid or scything courses.
