Purpose of the role

To help monitor the health and welfare of BBOWT's livestock at the above site.

Type of work in which you will be involved

To check the correct number of livestock are present, carry out a visual health check of the animals (training provided), ensure they have adequate water and grazing and check the integrity of fences and gates. They are also expected to report issues of any other types to BBOWT staff.

Skills required

No experience necessary, but an interest in animal welfare is important. Training will be provided. This is a solo role, so a willingness to carry out duties unsupervised is essential.
