Role title	East Berkshire Midweek Team Volunteer
Based at location	Woolley Firs nr Maidenhead, plus various BBOWT reserves in Berkshire, from Slough to Newbury
Purpose of the role	The Midweek Team carries out a wide variety of practical tasks to maintain and enhance BBOWT's many nature reserves in Berkshire.
Type of work in which you will be involved	Work includes fencing, coppicing, meadow and woodland ride cutting and raking, path clearance and access work, scrub clearance and more.
Experience &/or qualifications needed	No experience is necessary as full training given; we just need keen, enthusiastic people. Limited spaces for lifts available, otherwise you will need your own transport.
Times/days we would like you to be available	Wednesdays, generally 9:30-4pm. Actual start and finish times depend on the location and nature of the work, and you will be informed by email or other communication ahead of time.
Benefits to volunteer & possible training opportunities	Volunteers will receive a full Health & Safety briefing the first time you come out. If you haven't been to a site before, you'll receive a brief history of the site, its wildlife interest and management plus an explanation of the task for the day work and why it is being carried out. BBOWT arranges annual thank-you events with opportunities to meet other volunteers and staff and hear about the activities and strategies of the Berks, Bucks and Oxon Wildlife Trust. We also have an email newsletter for volunteers called Grapevine.
